#### FITNESS / ATHLETIC FACILITY

#### FITNESS/AQUATICS ATTIRE

Exercise attire appropriate to country club workout facilities is required. Shirts must be worn at all times. Shorts are to be no shorter than mid-thigh in length. Low rise shorts or pants are not permitted. Midriffbaring shirts and undergarments worn as outergarments are not permitted. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times.

Proper and modest swimming attire is to be worn at all times when using the pool. An appropriate coverup is to be worn over swimsuits when outside the pool and snack bar area. Sports caps must be worn with bills forward.

#### **AGE GUIDELINES**

- Children under age 16 are not permitted in the FC unless certified by a certified Trainer.
- TEEN FITNESS CERTIFIED children (ages 12-15)
   are permitted to use the exercise equipment.
- Children between the ages of 12 15 may train
   ONLY under the following conditions:
  - Under training of a staff /pro; or
  - after getting TEEN FITNESS CERTIFIED with a Staff Trainer.
- Children age 12 and under must always be accompanied by an adult. Ages 10 through 12 may be dropped off for swim team practice and then picked up.
- Members younger than 21 years of age are not permitted to bring guests to the FC.
- Persons younger than the age of 21 are not permitted on the lower level of the AF unless they are playing tennis, are part of an organized fitness class, or accompanied by an adult.
- The Lower Level Locker Rooms, including the Steam Rooms and Saunas, are reserved exclusively for ages 21 years of age and older.

Smoking is prohibited in the Athletic Facility.

Cell phone use is not permitted except in designated areas (entry vestibules of building). F & B -except for bottled water and catered food & beverage should be consumed in the Center Court Café.

#### **BHCC GOLF**

#### **GOLF ATTIRE**

Appropriate golf attire is required for everyone using the golf course, driving range, and practice facilities. Individuals not appropriately attired shall be asked to change their attire or be denied use of the golf facilities. Metal spikes are not permitted anywhere on the Club's premises.

#### MEN

Shirts with golf collars and sleeves, turtlenecks/mock turtlenecks, slacks, or golf shorts are appropriate. Golf shirts must be tucked-in at all times even if manufactured to be worn untucked. Golf caps must be worn forward.

#### LADIES

Dresses, slacks, medium-length skirts and shorts, and golf shirts in various styles are appropriate. Golf shirts may be sleeveless shirts with collars or collarless shirts with sleeves. Shirts designed and manufactured to be untucked may be worn untucked.

NOTE: Jeans, denim, sweat pants, athletic shorts, cargo shorts or pants are not permitted.

# AGE GUIDELINES GOLF LOCKER ROOMS:

Age 16 and older without an adult.

Age 15 and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

#### **GOLF CARTS**

- Only individuals with a valid driver's license may rent a golf cart. An adult must accompany anyone without a valid license on a golf cart.
- Children under 6 years of age must be accompanied by an adult when on the golf course, driving range, chipping green or practice putting green.
- Certified Juniors may golf unaccompanied.

Smoking is prohibited anywhere in the Clubhouse.
Cell phone use is not permitted in the Clubhouse except in designated areas (entry vestibules of building and main stairwell area).

## DOUBLE EAGLE PUB, HILLIARD ROOM & ADJACENT PATIO

#### **DOUBLE EAGLE PUB**

Age guideline: 21 and above.

#### **HILLIARD ROOM - PATIO**

Ages 13 & older may dine unaccompanied. Ages 12 & younger must dine with an adult.

#### **ATTIRE:**

Throughout the day: CASUAL\*

#### \*CASUAL

Casual attire with the exception of clothing items not permitted below. Golf and tennis attire are permitted. Men's golf and tennis collared casual shirts must be tucked in at all times and in all areas of the Clubhouse. Dress shirts must be tucked in unless manufactured to be worn untucked.

#### \*\*SMART CASUAL

For men and boys, 13 years of age and above, collared shirts with sleeves, turtlenecks/mock turtlenecks with long sleeves, dress shorts, denim clothing, all shirts tucked in including those dress shirts manufactured to be worn untucked. Comparable attire for ladies and girls, except shirts designed to be untucked may be worn untucked.

#### \*\*\*BUSINESS

For men and boys 13 years of age and above, jackets, collared shirts, turtlenecks/mock turtlenecks, long slacks, no jeans, denim or athletic shoes. Ties are optional. All dress shirts are to be tucked in including dress shirts manufactured to be untucked. Comparable attire for ladies & girls except shirts designed to be untucked may be worn untucked.

**NOTE:** For men and boys, hats, golf caps & visors are permitted on the lower level and outside areas only, and must be worn with bills forward. **Ladies' and girls** fashion hats and golf caps are permitted throughout the clubhouse. Golf shoes are permitted on the lower level only.

#### **NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME**

Men/boys ages 13 & above: T-shirts, undershirts, tank tops, workout attire, cleats, gym shorts, cutoff shorts, sweat shirts and pants, swim suits, rubber flip flops, bare feet, torn, patched excessively dirty, frayed, excessively loose or baggy clothing, untucked shirts (except where noted above).

Women/girls ages 13 & above: T-shirts, halter tops, workout attire, undergarments worn as out-garments, cleats, gym shorts, cutoff shorts, sweat shirts and pants, swim suits, rubber flip flops, bare feet, torn, patched, excessively dirty, frayed, excessively loose or baggy clothing.

**Children ages 12 & under:** Workout attire, cleats, gym shorts, cutoff shorts, sweat shirts & pants, swim suits, rubber flip flops, bare feet, torn, patched, excessively dirty, frayed, excessively loose or baggy clothing.

#### **TENNIS ATTIRE**

All clothing and accessories (shoes, hats, visors, and warm-up suits, etc.) must be manufactured for tennis.

- Tennis outfits must be predominantly white (i.e. 50% or greater).
- Colored warm-up suits may be worn; however, when any single item of the warm-up is removed, the resulting visible outfit must be predominantly white.
- Shoes must be manufactured for tennis with nonmarking soles.
- All shorts for men and boys must be sidepocketed and above the knee in length.
- All shirts for men and boys must have sleeves.
- Men and boys ages 17 and older must wear collared shirts.
- Boys 16 and under, may wear collarless/ crewneck shirts manufactured for tennis.
- Ladies may wear sleeveless tops.
- Tennis caps must be worn with bills forward at all times.
